CRATING/BUILDING ACCESS/CHAIRS



The crating room is at the back of the building! It is climate controlled and has ceiling fans! There is a TV with Agility Gate displayed and a TV showing runs in the ring! Crating will open for setup on Thursday from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. and each morning at 7 a.m. when the building opens to competitors. Please use the side door from the driveway to enter the crating room.



Crating is inside the orange taped off area only. If you need assistance with finding crating space, please see Lisa Miller or Brigitte Campanaro. If you are saving crating space for friends, do not save more space than absolutely needed! We reserve the right to move tarps, crates, and chairs as needed to insure everyone has space to crate their dogs. There is no crating along the front, back, or side walls of the crating room without permission from Lisa or Brigitte.



Please keep your crating space as tight as possible within the taped area so we can fit everyone in. Please **STACK CRATES** whenever possible and especially if you have unentered dogs with you! We discourage the use of tent crates due to their size.



Please bring **CRATE COVERS**! Crates will be placed back-to-back in each row. If using soft sided crates, you must zip the top when your dog is in their crate unless you are there with your dog. Dogs with open crates or outside of their crate in the aisles are a safety issue with dogs walking down the aisle. Please keep your dogs in their closed crate except when entering or leaving the crating area.



CHAIRS: Your chair must be placed in **FRONT** of your crate in the walkway. No chairs inside the orange taped off crating area. Instead of placing chairs in the crate room, the front of the ring by the kitchen will be spectators only inside the taped area. Please one chair per spectator (either in the crate room or the front spectator area, not both). Please No lounge chairs or double chairs.



SMOKING/VAPING

Radda's K9 Campus does not permit smoking or vaping anywhere on their property including your car or RV! Violations will be taken seriously. Please report violations to Lisa Miller or Brigitte Campanaro.

FOOD

WE DO NOT HAVE A FOOD TRUCK for this trial so please plan accordingly! There are places to get food within 15 minutes of the arena. If you are planning a MACH/PACH party, please confirm with Lisa Miller for availability of the kitchen. We can only accommodate 1 party per day.



We will provide water for volunteers in the cooler in the kitchen. There is a Kuerig coffee machine in the kitchen and we will have K-cups and creamer available. Feel free to also bring your own K-Cups.



PARKING

- Please follow signs and directions from people helping direct traffic.
- Please do not park in the reserved parking spaces at the front of the building.
- If parking on the gravel in front of the building, please park as close as possible to the other cars to still allow room to get dogs in and out of each car while maximizing parking space. Please leave spaces closer to the entrance for people crating out of their cars. If crating from a van, please back into the parking space.
- There is no parking directly behind the building! There is plenty of gravel parking straight ahead on the right past the RVs that will be on your left!
- If it is raining, you park at your own risk in the front pasture. Towing fees will be at your expense if you get stuck!
- Please do not park along the fenced dog yard or anywhere across from the RVs. You will be asked to move your vehicle if you park in these areas without express permission.
- RV PARKING IS PAID ONLY! No unauthorized vehicles may park in any RV spot!
- The front gate does not typically open until 7 a.m. Please do not come early to help avoid cars backing up traffic while waiting for the gate to open!



RESTROOMS

There are 2 restrooms inside on the front side of the building and 2 porta potties at the back of the building.

One is outside the crate room door and the other is around the corner on the back of the building.



RING FLOW/DOGS in FRONT OF RING

- You will enter the building by the **FRONT** door to run. You must go outside from the crating room and walk to the front of the building. Exits from the ring will be through one of the doors to the crating room. Please, no more than the next 5 dogs in the front part of the building.
- Please keep your dog close and pay attention to them to avoid any unfortunate dog-to-dog contact. Space is tight everywhere. We will do our best to place your dogs as far apart as possible if you run 2+ dogs. See the Gate, Chief Ring Steward, or Trial Chair if you need to move your dog. If you have puppies you want to socialize, you may bring them into the spectator area **ONLY** during course builds and walk thrus or after the trial. No dogs other than the next 5 dogs running while a class is in progress.



MUDDY/GRASS COVERED SHOES

Please bring one pair of shoes to wear outside when in the fields and another pair of clean shoes for inside on the turf. Please help us keep the building and turf clean and avoid additional cleaning charges! There are boot scrapers in the front and by the crating room door to clean mud/grass from your shoes. Please use them and check your shoes (sides, heels, and bottoms) before entering the building. Messy shoes are not permitted inside the building.



There will be towels by the entrance to both the front of the building and the crate room to wipe muddy/wet paws before entering the ring if it's raining!



POOP BAGS

- Please clean up after your dogs and place all poop bags in an outside trash can. Do not leave them sitting outside on the ground or door stoops! There is no poop fairy in attendance! Please do not allow your dogs to pee on any manmade objects.
- If you are staying at the Microtel Hotel there are orange buckets on each end of the building near the door and a small bucket on the lamp post across from the front entrance. All poop bags must be placed in these containers or the dumpster. Please do not put poop bags in any hotel trash can.
